

Semi-Annual Clean-up Days:

Spring Clean-up will usually be in March- and will be announced. Fall Clean-up will be the 1st full week after the second week-end of Scenic Drive (this year it will start October 12-16, 2009) You put out your extra's on your regular garbage day. You may set out appliances and other oversized items. **NO building materials, tires, paints or batteries.**

Burning: **Only dry landscape waste may be burned**, no trash or building materials and No burning of grass clippings.

No burning at all on Mondays (only weiner roasts/firepits)

No burning before 8 am.

No burning after 7 pm.

Weiner roast fires will be allowed until 11pm. If it is a large weiner roast fire, please call City Hall so they can notify the Police in case someone calls complaining about burning.

Yard Waste Collection

The City and Knoxville Hardware sell bags to use for yard waste. They can **ONLY** be purchased at these two places. If you have purchased bags elsewhere the only way we will collect them is purchasing a sticker to put on the bag. Stickers can be purchased at City Hall for yard waste deposited in garbage cans and/or bundles of branches.

Bags \$1.25 each

Stickers \$1.75 each
